KICK-OFF MEETING IN Rotterdam, The Netherlands

In October 2018, partners from seven European countries (Austria, Denmark, Greece, Ireland, Italy, The Netherlands and Spain) gathered for a kick-off meeting to discuss and agree on the detailed plan for project implementation and the schedule for fulfilling the ambitious project targets and to set up short-term tasks. During this first meeting the partners shared experiences about the situation and the existing methodologies and practices in their countries and exchanged ideas for the development of the project methodology.

WHAT'S NEXT ON IRENE

- Conduct a survey to get a clear picture of what the needs of adults with learning difficulties are and to collect good practice examples of existing teaching methodologies in partner countries.
- Hold a second work meeting on 25 and 26th February 2019 in Larissa, Greece. The partners will present and discuss the results of the survey and hold a workshop to create the initial draft of the methodology.

The project will be run from September 1st 2018 till August 31st 2021.
